The goal of the Wetumpka Youth Baseball/Softball Recreation Activities ("WYRSA") is to provide a fun, safe, and positive learning environment for every child in the greater Wetumpka community desiring to participate in sporting activities. In addition, the WYRSA volunteer coach program ensures we can train and equip community members who will emphasize sportsmanship, honesty, integrity, respect, personal responsibility, and fairness.

As a coach, I shall:

- ➤ Be a positive role model.
- > Remain sensitive to the physical and emotional well-being of the players on my team.
- > Display and instill in my players the principles of good sportsmanship and team play.
- Do my best to provide a positive experience for all players.
- Ensure my team always displays respect and good sportsmanship towards other players.
- Treat all players, parents, spectators, and league officials with respect.
- Provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive.
- Never ridicule or demean players on my own or other teams, officials, parents, or other program participants.
- Not tolerate behavior that endangers the health or well-being of a child.
- ➤ Complete all required training, including concussion recognition education.
- Comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policies, and procedures as established or endorsed by Wetumpka Parks and Recreation (WPR).
- > Teach the sport to the best of my ability.
- > Be drug and alcohol-free while at any WPR athletic event.
- Refrain from using any tobacco products during a WPR activity.

I understand that Wetumpka Parks and Recreation has a **zero-tolerance policy**; any violation of the following could result in an indefinite suspension or lifetime ban from Parks and Recreation activities. This includes, but is not limited to:
